Tripping/falling from team challenge equipment	3	2	6	Correct instruction given for the use of each activity/element i.e. max 3 people on see saw at one time, only get on/off when end is down. Adequate supervision of all participants. When using guttering kit keep area tidy. When using water with the kit, ensure surface is non-slip.	1	2	3
Rope burn	1	2	3	Demonstrate correct placement of hands on ski ropes.	1	2	2
Splinters/abrasions	2	1	2	Check equipment for damage or wear. Brief user of possible injury and safe handling of equipment. Care taken when using guttering kit due to sharp corners that could scratch.	1	1	1
Injury from misuse of equipment.	2	2	4	Instruction given for the correct use of the equipment i.e. placing not throwing planks. Show how to clip guttering.	1	2	2
Injury from collision	2	1	1	Remove hazards from area. Participants warned of potential hazards to avoid. Maintain group control. When using guttering kit ensure 2 people carry the lengths of guttering to maintain control at both ends.	1	1	1
