Cameras/torches used inappropriately	2	2	4	Children should not keep cameras or torches or mobile phones in the bedroom. They should be placed in the designated boxes in the lounge and only used in public areas.	1	2	2
Pupils lost/ Abduction / personal safety	2	5	10	Pupils not to leave bedrooms after lights out and until 8am, except to go to the toilet or there is an emergency and it is necessary to speak to an adult. Pupils to be instructed not to open room doors to anyone unless they know who is there. Staff to patrol areas where students are sleeping after lights out until pupils are settled. Staff to be located near to children's rooms & children informed of their location & how to contact them if emergency / illness occurs. Staff to activate door access alarms when children are in their rooms.	1	5	5
Child abuse or allegations of abuse	2	3	6	Staff not to be alone with a child.	1	3	3

2. Give all wet/soiled clothing or bedding to an adult as soon as possible
