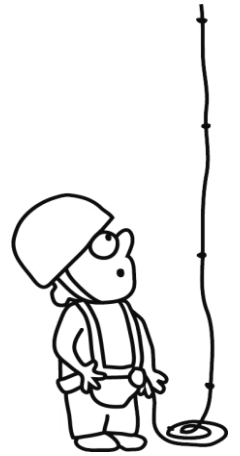

Activities we can offer you for your school residential please speak to the Lead Activity Worker

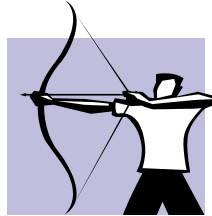
Climbing – All inside our heated and fully lit climbing barn we have Jacobs Ladder, Electron Ladder, Traverse wall and eight separate pitches of varying grades to suit all abilities and needs.

Bushcraft – amazing opportunity to use our woodland to learn about surviving in the outdoors – fire lighting, shelter building, cooking your own food.

Cycling – again using our amazing woodland paths, bumps and jumps children and young people can learn to ride and increase their own experience in the outdoor environment.



Archery – learn to shoot like Robin Hood in our climbing barn.



Nature Explorers – environmental education based session with an in-depth look at the wild life that lives around Lineham Farm. Activities include pond-dipping, gardening sensory games, bird spotting and following tracks and trails.

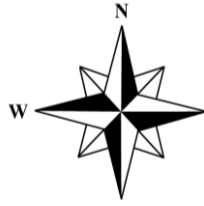
Animal Care – our unique farm offers children and young people to experience looking after and being with a number of different animals – this is a key experience for all children & young people and is part of every residential experience.



Night line – experience the nightline. Great for communication and listening skills usually a combination with the Low Ropes or Team Building activities.

Lineham Explorers – combination of animal care and woodland walk with an environmental theme.

Orienteering – children and young people get to ruin some energy off around the site against each other, learning about map reading and working together as a team.



Crate Stacking – a climbing challenge which encourages teamwork as children work together to build a high tower to balance on.

Country Trail on and off site - the country trail again looks at map reading, having fun in the countryside, country code, walking and wildlife spotting – choice of onsite or off site.



Team Games – this is a great end to the week or time at Lineham and brings together all the skills the children and young people have learnt.

Low Ropes – our fantastic low ropes course has twelve different activities and is designed again for team work and listening skills.

Heartstart – brilliant session for young people to get a certificate to show that they can call someone in an emergency, remain calm and understand what to do in a possible emergency situation.

Night Walk – very exciting start to your residential, the children and young people are taken on the night walk to start their week off in style through our woodland and around our fields – great for stargazing!

Self-led Campfire – sing some songs, cook some marshmallows, enjoy the great outdoors round the fire in our woodland area. Great for bringing the group together for some reflection and evaluation.
